NAEMT TCCC Courses

<u>Advantages</u>

- 1. They use the standardized JTS/CoTCCC curricula with no deviation.
- 2. NAEMT has a worldwide infrastructure that has been used to teach TCCC to military units in a rapidly expanding number of countries around the world (23 countries as of 24 Feb 2017 with three more to be added in the next few months.)
- 3. Courses are taught by NAEMT-certified instructors.
- 4. There is a well-established NAEMT system for setting up training sites.
- 5. The <u>TCCC Certification Card</u> provided to students at the end of the course is endorsed by:

ACS-COT
NAEMT
Joint Trauma System
CoTCCC

- 6. NAEMT maintains a registry of all TCCC students who complete the course.
- 7. NAEMT TCCC courses are less expensive than commercial training vendors. There is a \$10 fee for the 16-hour TCCC for Medical Personnel course which is designed for medics, corpsmen, PJs, physicians, nurses, PAs, and MSC officers. Vendor-provided TCCC course fees are typically much higher.
- 8. The NAEMT TCCC course is appropriate to be offered through the Military Training Network, just as ATLS and ACLS are if USUHS agrees.
- 9. NAEMT can train either of the two TCCC courses:

TCCC for Medical Personnel TCCC for All Combatants

NAEMT TCCC Course/Instructor Certification

- 1. Courses are conducted at NAEMT-accredited sites
 - Have a designated Course Coordinator
 - Have the required training equipment
 - All TCCC students who complete the course must be entered in the NAEMT TCCC registry
 - All TCCC students who complete the course will be given a TCCC Certification Card endorsed by:

NAEMT ACS COT JTS CoTCCC

- 2. NAEMT Training Site TCCC Course Coordinators are NAEMT certified by:
 - Having successfully completed an NAEMT TCCC provider course
 - Having taken the NAEMT instructor course (see below)
 - Having taught at least one TCCC course monitored by the cognizant NAEMT Affiliate Faculty
 - Teaching at least one TCCC course per year to maintain their current Instructor status.
- 3. Instructors are NAEMT certified by:
 - Having successfully completed an NAEMT TCCC provider course
 - Having taken the NAEMT instructor course (see below)
 - Having taught at least one TCCC course monitored by the Course Coordinator or the cognizant NAEMT Affiliate Faculty
 - Teaching at least one TCCC course per year to maintain their current Instructor status.
- 4. Instructor/Student Ratio is 1 instructor per 6 or less students (recommended) or 1 instructor per 8 or less students (maximum) in the course.
- 5. Course content must either:
 - 1. Use the current JTS-developed TCCC curriculum in its entirety OR
 - 2. Have the Course Coordinator at the training site and the cognizant NAEMT Affiliate Faculty certify in writing that the course:
 - Teaches everything in the JTS-developed TCCC curriculum with no deviation AND
 - Is not shorter than 2 days for the TCCC-MP course

- 6. Students must pass the written TCCC test as generated by the JTS/CoTCCC developed TCCC Test Generator.
- 7. Students must successfully complete all of the required JTS/CoTCCC-developed TCCC skill sheets.
- 8. The TCCC Certification Card is good for a 4 year period. (as with ATLS)

Notes:

- * Recent discussions with representatives from a number of DoD organizations have indicated that the TCCC for All Combatants course can be taught effectively at the unit level, resulting in a multi-million dollar cost reduction in comparison to having this course taught through NAEMT (which entails a cost of \$10 per TCCC student.) NAEMT TCCC for All Combatant courses remain available for both military and law enforcement units who choose that option.
- * An electronic version of the upcoming TCCC Handbook will be provided at no cost to all NAEMT TCCC students.
- * There is a \$44.95 NAEMT online instructor course. This cost is reduced to \$33.25 when purchased in groups of 5 or more. The NAEMT instructor course can also be taught as a classroom course for \$10 per student instructor if desired.
- * The current version of the PHTLS textbook (Military) is a required resource for TCCC instructors. These textbooks should be made available as a shared resource at NAEMT-certified TCCC training sites. They are not required to be purchased by individual TCCC instructors or students. The list price for this textbook is \$82.95. This cost is reduced to \$62 when 5 or more are purchased.
- * PHTLS Military eBook and Interactive Tools Access: List price is \$40.95 (reduced to \$30.75 when 5 or more are purchased).
