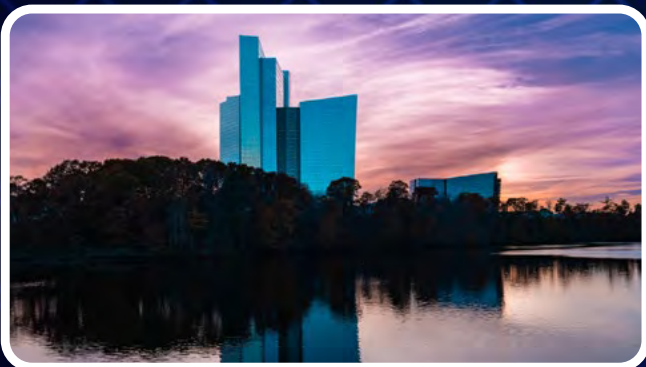

New subscribers must qualify for FirstNet service and complete verification process within 30 days. **Check eligibility at firstnet.com/eligibility.** Requires FirstNet-Capable device provisioned with a FirstNet Trio SIM or eSIM card. **Limits:** Maximum of 4 lines (1 smartphone, 1 tablet, 1 wearable, 1 connected device) per eligible FirstNet Subscriber Paid User. Account subject to periodic re-verification. **If you are not a valid Subscriber Paid User or exceed the single line limit for each type of device, AT&T may suspend, change or terminate your FirstNet service.** For additional info, see firstnet.com/firstnetandfamily. **Requirements:** Must purchase bring your own compatible, unlocked Apple iPhone ("BYOD"). Must port-in new line from an eligible third-party carrier for that device and activate it on an eligible wireless plan. Customers porting with a temporary number must override the temporary with a permanent number within 14 days. **Required Wireless:** FirstNet Unlimited plan or FirstNet Mobile Responder Unlimited plan (min. \$42.99/month). **Bill Credits:** Receive \$25/month credit for 24 months (total \$600 in credits) starting within 2 bill cycles after all requirements have been met. **Tax on wireless service, if any, is calculated prior to application of monthly bill credit.** To qualify for bill credits, your BYOD and line must remain active and in good standing for thirty (30) days. To get all credits, BYOD must stay on eligible service for 24 months after credits start. **If you cancel or change service, credits may end. 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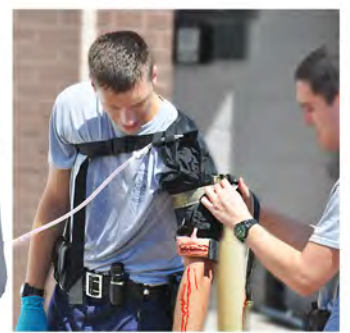
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TRAUMA

Prehospital Trauma Life Support/PHTLS

16 CE hours. Developed in cooperation with American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma (ACS COT).



- World's premier prehospital emergency trauma care program.
- Addresses multi-system trauma.
- Reinforces rapid and orderly assessment, immediate treatment of life-threatening problems; minimizing delays in initiating transport to an appropriate destination.
- 8-hour **PHTLS for First Responders** course also offered.

Tactical Combat Casualty Care/TCCC

Created by U.S. Dept. of Defense.



- Introduces evidence-based, life-saving techniques and strategies for providing the best trauma care on the battlefield.
- NAEMT offers the following TCCC courses: TCCC for All Service Members, TCCC Combat Lifesaver, and TCCC Combat Medic/Corpsman.

Tactical Emergency Casualty Care/TECC

16 CE hours. Endorsed by American College of Surgeons. Meets Committee on TECC guidelines.



- Teaches civilian tactical EMS for EMS clinicians called upon to respond to a mass casualty, active shooter, or other hostile event.
- Covers the three phases of tactical care.
- Topics include: hemorrhage control; MARCH assessment; airway control and needle decompression; pediatric patients; moving victims to safety; and mass casualty/active shooter simulations.
- 8-hour **TECC-LEO** course also offered.

All Hazards Disaster Response/AHDR

Community Paramedicine Series/CP

CE hours vary by course.

- Provides EMS clinicians at all levels the skills and knowledge to handle the unique medical, social, environmental, and communication challenges of older adults.
- Empowers EMS clinicians to improve medical outcomes and quality of life for geriatric patients.



Psychological Trauma in EMS Patients/PTEP

8 CE hours.

- Provides resources to help alleviate patients' hidden wounds (intense fear, stress, and pain during a medical emergency).
- Educates EMS clinicians about the biological underpinnings of psychological trauma and teaches strategies to alleviate patients' distress.



OPERATIONAL

Breaking Bad News/BBN

3 CE hours.

- Prepares EMS clinicians to deliver death notifications to patients' families with care and compassion.



EMS Safety

8 CE hours.

- Promotes a culture of safety by increasing awareness/understanding of EMS safety standards and practices.
- Trains EMS clinicians to identify and address the hazards in daily tasks, such as distracted drivers, agitated patients, chronic stress, etc., to reduce the number of injuries and fatalities.



EMS Safety Officer/ESO

5 CE hours.

- Prepares EMS personnel to serve as their agency's EMS Safety Officer.
- Teaches EMS personnel to assess safety in facilities, vehicles, and emergency scenes, and to use best practices for preventing infections and maximizing patient and personal safety.



EMS Vehicle Operator Safety/EVOS

8 or 16 CE hours.

- Addresses the knowledge gap that leads to injuries and deaths.
- Focuses on the behaviors that need to change to create a culture of safe driving.
- Features analyses of both common and catastrophic collisions.
- Challenges EMS clinicians to reconsider their preconceptions about safe vehicle operations.



Principles of Ethics and Personal Leadership/PEPL

16 CE hours.

- Provides EMS clinicians with the knowledge and skills needed to effectively interact with patients, their families, other medical personnel, co-workers, supervisors, and the community.
- Helps students identify their personal responsibility and accountability for ethical decision-making.



Mental Health Resilience Officer/MHRO

8 CE hours.

- Helps EMS agencies build and support the mental health resilience of their personnel.

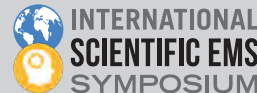

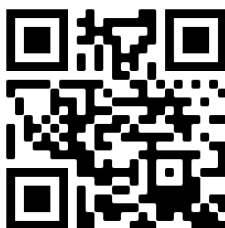

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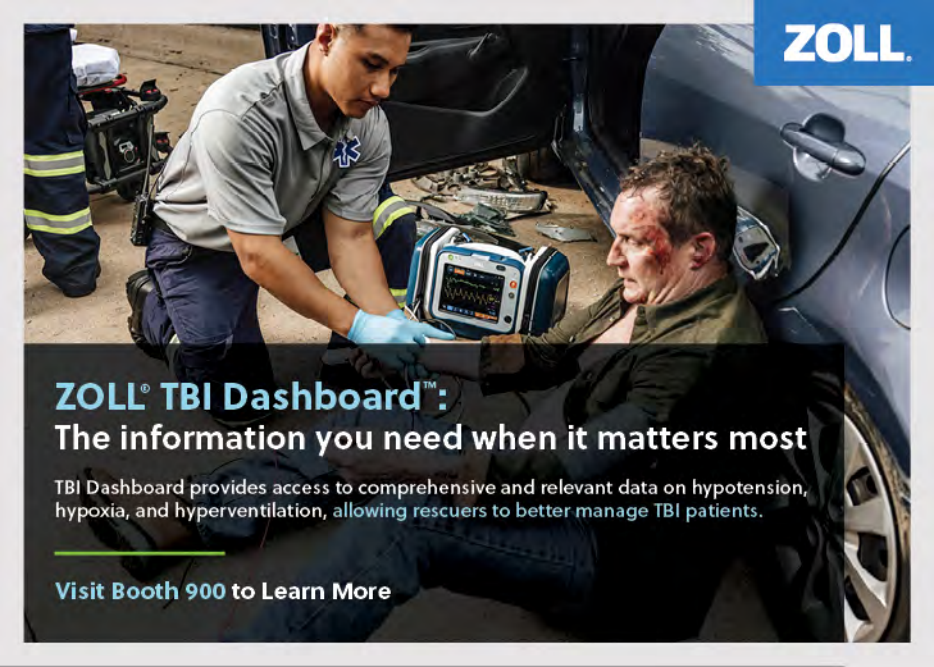
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
