

STATEMENT OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
REGARDING BYLAWS CHANGES

NAEMT Active members will be asked to vote on [proposed bylaws changes](#) during the 2022 election.

The proposed bylaws revisions include the following new qualification for Directors:

- current engagement as an EMS practitioner, EMS manager, or EMS instructor of initial or continuing education with an average minimum of 15 hours/week.

If approved, the revised bylaws will go into effect on January 1, 2023. Additionally, in order to be eligible to serve on the 2023 NAEMT Board, the bylaws will require the following from all Board members – those who are elected in 2022 and those whose terms will continue in 2023:

- Current engagement as an EMS practitioner, EMS manager, or EMS instructor of initial or continuing education with an average minimum of 15 hours/week.
- **Due by November 30, 2022:** Written verification from the candidate’s service or EMS agency or educational institution confirming that the candidate serves an average minimum of 15 hours/week, the candidate’s level of commitment to the profession, and the employer’s support for the time commitment required for the position being sought.
 - If the employer is different from the EMS service or agency or education institution, a letter from the candidate’s employer confirming their support for the time commitment required for the position being sought;
 - If the candidate is self-employed, a written recommendation from an EMS colleague who is an NAEMT active member confirming the candidate’s level of commitment to the profession and the candidate’s ability to meet the time commitment required for the position being sought.
